EXPENSE OVERVIEW 2016-2017

1. Due August:

- Dance Camp Fees \$250 (all companies, excluding Pres). Pre dance camp fee \$150
- Jacket (must have at least one) – Hoodie \$50.00 or Track Jacket \$85.00 (required to purchase LAST day of camp). Order forms available in studio lobby.
- Ballet Uniforms (all companies) approx. \$25.00 – Required 1st day of class fall classes (ordered through online boutique)

2. Due August or Distributed All Year

- Company registration - \$400.00
 - o Can be divided into 10 payments of \$40.00 each month or paid in full at time of registration
- Company Costumes
 - o Deposits - \$50.00/class dance. Due at Registration
 - **Pres: 4 deposits**
 - Ballet
 - Tap
 - Jazz
 - Hip Hop
 - **Petites: 5-6 deposits**
 - Ballet
 - Tap
 - Jazz
 - Musical Theater
 - Lyrical
 - Hip Hop (optional)
 - - **Minis, Tweens, Juniors, Teens, Seniors: 5-8 deposits**
 - Ballet
 - Tap (required for Minis and Tweens)
 - Jazz
 - Musical Theater
 - Lyrical
 - Contemporary
 - Hip Hop (optional)
 - Pointe (will require recreational costume deposit of \$25)
 - Tuition Begins

3. September 15th – Draft for JUMP convention (approx. \$250/dancer)

4. Due October 1st

- Small Group/Large Group Fees (optional dances – cost TBD depending on choreographer, ranging between \$80-\$300 invite only)
- Small Group/Large Group Costume Deposits (\$50.00 each)
- Accessories – Appropriate tights and appropriate shoes for each dance will be determined by November 2016
- Guest Choreographers – if applicable (\$175-\$275 per dancer)
- Master classes – if applicable (approx. \$45 per class – may be taken from registration fee)

5. Due November

- Make-Up (Seminar is in September – kits will be available to purchase in at this seminar)
 - o All companies will need to purchase required MAC make up
 - o Approximate cost - \$140.00
- Accessories
 - o Earrings, chokers
 - Everyone needs a choker. If you do not have one, please purchase from CDP office by November. If you have one and it is UGLY, please replace it. (Cost: \$40.00)
- Guest Choreographers – if applicable (\$175-\$275 per dancer)

6. Due December, January, February, March

- IHIH Convention (approx. \$60)
- Entry Fees (are drafted on the 15th of the month according to competition dates)
 - o Approximately \$50.00 per dancer, per group dance for each competition
 - o Approximately \$110.00 Solo/Duet/Trio for each competition
- Convention Costs
 - o Approximately \$250.00 for each convention registration fee

7. Due February, March, April

- Competition expenses
 - o Travel expenses for 2-4 competitions (hotel, food, gas)
- Remaining costume balances (this may be split between April and May)
- Reconcile registration fee (this may be split between April and May)

8. May

- Company Auditions (approx. \$35)
- Remaining costume balances (this may be split between April and May)
- Reconcile registration fee (this may be split between April and May)

Other expense notes:

Solos: \$375/choreo + 4hrs rehearsal

Duets: \$275 per dancer/choreo + 4hrs rehearsal

Trios: \$225 per dancer/choreo + 4hr rehearsal

Studio rental fee: \$10/30min

***Solo/duet/trio fees are to be handled directly between choreographer and student.

Payment will need to be made directly to your instructor prior to meeting. There will be no required costume deposit for solos/duets/trios.
