

### CDP AWARD CEREMONY...

- Be on the lookout for our trophy list. We will post this online. Please email the studio with any name misspellings, or corrections ([info@carydance.com](mailto:info@carydance.com)).
- Awards will be given out for the following attendance years (years DO NOT have to be consecutive)
  - 3, 5, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 years
  - graduating seniors
  - teacher assistants
- If your child is receiving a trophy, we will need them backstage 2 dances before intermission/awards.
- If your dancer is still with their class, the dresser moms will take them backstage at the appropriate time
- After trophies are passed out, students will remain on stage until curtains close. They will then be ushered by CDP staff back to their dressing rooms for act 2, or to collect their belongings for pick up.

### CDP RECITAL PARKING...

There are multiple lots near the theater. Look for signs that read EVENT PARKING. Parking is approximately \$7.00 per car. Handicapped accessible parking for Daily Box Office is located on Wilmington Street, adjacent to Memorial Auditorium.

#### **MEMORIAL AUDITORIUM POLICIES AND SHOW ETIQUETTE:**

- NO FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED IN THE THEATRE OR BACKSTAGE
- THE ENTIRE DUKE ENERGY CENTER IS A NON-SMOKING FACILITY
- NO ONE IS ALLOWED INTO THE THEATRE AUDITORIUM UNTIL 45 MINUTES PRIOR TO SHOWTIME
- AUDIENCE MEMBERS WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO GO IN OR OUT OF THE THEATER BETWEEN NUMBERS
- NO VIDEO CAMERAS OR FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY DURING THE SHOW
- CRYING CHILDREN SHOULD BE TAKEN OUT OF THE THEATRE IMMEDIATELY
- CELL PHONES SHOULD BE TURNED OFF DURING PERFORMANCES

**IMPORTANT DISCLAIMER:** The schedule and information below is tentative and subject to change based on government and facility restrictions, and the health and safety of our CDP dancers, families, and staff. You can expect us to be in touch about audience limitations, safety precautions and requirements, dressing room guidelines and more as we near these events. We are sharing the information below to help you get a sense of how the day will run, although the actual day might look a little different than outlined below.

#### **All Studio Recital Shows: Saturday, June 19th 2021**

##### **Show 1: 10:00am**

Doors open at 9:15am to dressing rooms and auditorium  
Show length is approximately 2 hours  
20 minute awards and intermission at approx. 11:00am  
Show ends at approximately 12:30pm

##### **Show 2: 2:00pm**

Doors open at 1:15pm to dressing rooms and auditorium  
Show length is approximately 2 hours  
20 minute awards and intermission at approx. 3:00pm  
Show ends at approximately 4:30pm

##### **Show 3: 6:00pm**

Doors open at 5:15pm to dressing room and auditorium  
Show length is approximately 2 hours  
20 minute awards and intermission at approx. 7:00pm  
Show ends at approximately 8:30pm

**DRESS REHEARSAL is on Friday, June 18th at Memorial Auditorium.**  
**Please see recital show schedule for your class's stage rehearsal time.**

### CDP DRESSER MOM INFO...

- Each class of dancers will have a designated dressing room/area. Because space is limited, and to keep a smooth running show, we cannot accommodate all parents in this space — we instead assign dresser moms to each group of dancers (these are parent volunteers). Depending on the class size, we will need between 2-4 dresser moms per group.
- Dresser moms are required to help for both dress rehearsal (June 18th) and your specific recital show (June 19th).
- Dresser moms will be responsible for supervising dancers before, between, and after dancing. They will make sure dancers are lined up in their correct order for stage (line-up directions will be provided, don't worry!), help dancers change into their next costumes, and wait with them until picked up by parents.
- Each class will be assigned a parent pick up time (either at intermission or at the end of the show) depending on when dancers perform their last dance.
- If dancers have a long break between performances, we will have a designated area for dresser moms to take their class to watch in the audience.
- Once the girls are backstage, dresser moms can go to their designated seating area in the audience to watch the dancers perform (dresser moms must come backstage immediately following the routine to take the dancers back to their assigned dressing room).
- Dresser moms will receive one ticket for admission in the reserved "dresser mom seating" area. If you are a dresser mom and would like to sit with your family after your entire class has been picked up, you will need to purchase a separate ticket.
- Details about dresser mom selection will be available as we near the event.

### CDP DRESS REHEARSAL INFO...

- Our dress rehearsal will be held in the Memorial Auditorium in downtown Raleigh on Friday, June 18th.
- Dancers are required to wear costumes, performance make-up, hair, shoes, tights, and any required accessories (exactly as they would for the actual show).
- An instruction page for hair and make-up is available on our website.
- You will find your assigned dress rehearsal stage time on the recital show order documents posted online and at the dance studio. **DANCERS ARE REQUIRED TO ARRIVE PERFORMANCE READY 45 MINUTES PRIOR TO THIS TIME.** Please don't forget to factor in time for parking and traffic!
- Dancers should arrive to dress rehearsal ALREADY DRESSED in their first costume. Parents are required to drop dancers off at the dressing room table in the lobby of the auditorium. From here, a CDP staff member will take your dancer back to their assigned dressing room. Dancers will stay with their assigned dresser moms until assigned pick up time.

### CDP DRESS REHEARSAL INFO CONTINUED...

- Please make sure all costume pieces are LABELED and organized. Since dresser moms are the only parents allowed in the dressing area, organization is key to a smooth running show :)
- Once dancers have been dropped off at the dressing room table in the lobby, parents will be able to sit in the auditorium to watch rehearsal.
- Once your child has finished their last dance of the day, please immediately pick them up from the dressing room drop off in the lobby.
- **You may video tape at dress rehearsal - NOT RECITAL! Videos of recital performance will be available for purchase at CDP and at the recital venue.**
- **No food or drink allowed in the auditorium or dressing room!**

### CDP RECITAL DAY... DROP OFF AND PICK UP

- The doors will open 45 minutes prior to each show. Please do not come any earlier, as we will be setting up/cleaning, and the theater doors will be locked.
- Dancers must be dropped off performance ready, already wearing their first costume with additional costumes and accessories labeled in a bag.
- There is no flash photography or video taping allowed on recital day. We will have a professional videographer with order forms available in our studio lobby, and at the recital show.
- Audience members should only enter and exit the auditorium during applause, BETWEEN DANCES. This is a special event for ALL dancers in a beautiful theater (please dress accordingly).
- Any class participating in the first act only will need to be dropped off 45 minutes prior to show time. Please pick up from dressing room table in the lobby of the auditorium at intermission.
- Any class in act two only will need to be dropped off at intermission in costume, and pick up at the end of show.
- Any class in both act one and act two must drop off 45 minutes prior to show time and pick up at the end of the show

### CDP FRIENDLY REMINDERS...

- Don't forget to bring your tickets to the show (not to dress rehearsal)!
- Take dancers to the bathroom before dropping them off at the dressing room table (both for dress rehearsal and recital).
- Send an extra kit of bobby pins, safety pins, lipstick, hairspray, etc. with your dancer.
- No eating or drinking while in costume
